**Standard Member** - A standard member is any individual that has interest in emergency and disaster management. The standard member has voting rights at the General Assembly. **Annual fee is 95 (Euro)\***

**Professional Certified Member Standard** - An individual certified by TIEMS or another international organization. The certified professional member has voting rights at the General Assembly. **Annual fee is 125 (Euro)\***

**Student Member** - A Student Member must be a full-time student in good academic standing and must be nominated by a TIEMS Member or Student Member. The Student Member grade may be retained until December 31 in the year of graduation. This is a non-voting grade of membership. **Annual fee is 25 (Euro)\***

**Standard Member/Transition Economies** - This type of membership is the same as a Standard Member, but is reserved for persons who are from transition economies. See below for further details. **Annual fee is 35 (Euro)\***

**Professional Certified Member/Transition Economies** - This type of membership is the same as a Professional Certified Member, but is reserved for persons who are from transition economies. **Annual fee is 45 (Euro)\***

**Institutional Member** - The institutional member is for any legal entity which supports the initiatives and directives performed by TIEMS. An independent chapter of TIEMS (see article 10 of the statutes) is an institutional member. The institutional member has 5 votes at the General Assembly. **Annual fee is 310 (Euro)\***

### Active Member or Active Member/Transitional Economies?

Individuals from the following countries are considered to be an "Active Member". Individuals from countries NOT listed below are considered to be a "Transition Economy/Active Member". This list is based on the actual World Bank classification:

Andorra, Aruba, Australia, Austria, Bahamas, Bahrain, Barbados, Belgium, Bermuda, Brunei Darussalam, Canada, Cayman Islands, Channel Islands, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, France, Germany, Gibraltar, Greece, Greenland, Guam, Hong Kong SAR – China, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Isle of Man, Israel, Italy, Japan, Korea, Rep., Kuwait, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, New Caledonia, New Zealand, Northern Mariana Islands, Norway, Oman, Poland, Portugal, Puerto Rico, Qatar, San Marino, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Trinidad and Tobago.
